Since shovels are just going into the ground today, this update is centered around defining the work areas for those members who will be enjoying the property throughout the summer. As pictured below, construction fencing will enclose the worksite. When using the front sidewalks, please cross at the designated crosswalks. The greenside sidewalks will be barricaded on the east starting at the outdoor seating area under the yellow umbrellas and at the west, at the Enrichment Center.

During construction, the Gazebo and outdoor lakeside seating area will remain open. The Rookery will re-open soon and the Enrichment Center will be converted into an interim workout space. There will be no impact to parking or entrance/exit driveways.

PLEASE REMEMBER, this is a construction project and as such will present constantly changing situations each day. There will be movement of both materials and equipment, as well as deliveries to the worksite. Please be aware of your surroundings at all times, even if you are not near the fenced construction areas. If you see anything that you feel might present a safety concern, please reach out to me immediately.
